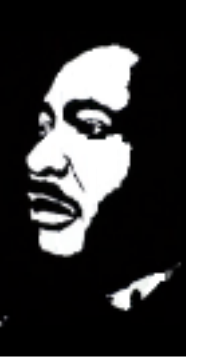


Today, More Than Ever... We Need the Legacy of Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr.
